PREPARE:

For this time of prayer and reflection, we invite you to find a comfortable position, light a candle it you wish and become aware of your breathing. When you are ready, slowly read the scripture reading and pause when you are drawn to stop and reflection on what you have read. Write down your thought and feeling to ponder on these later.

One week from today is Easter Sunday! We will celebrate the triumph of Jesus over the final enemy ... death! It is only correct and just that if we wish to join in the victory, then we should enter into the struggle, which precedes it.

During Lent, we have been given the opportunity to reflect upon the quality of our lives in the face of the Lenten Invitation: **Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel**. To help us in our Lenten response, the Readings for the five Sundays of Lent have given us a great deal of Food for Thought, and many opportunities to reawaken our inner spirit to follow Christ more wholeheartedly. As we said at the beginning of Lent, this is our Spiritual Training time.
